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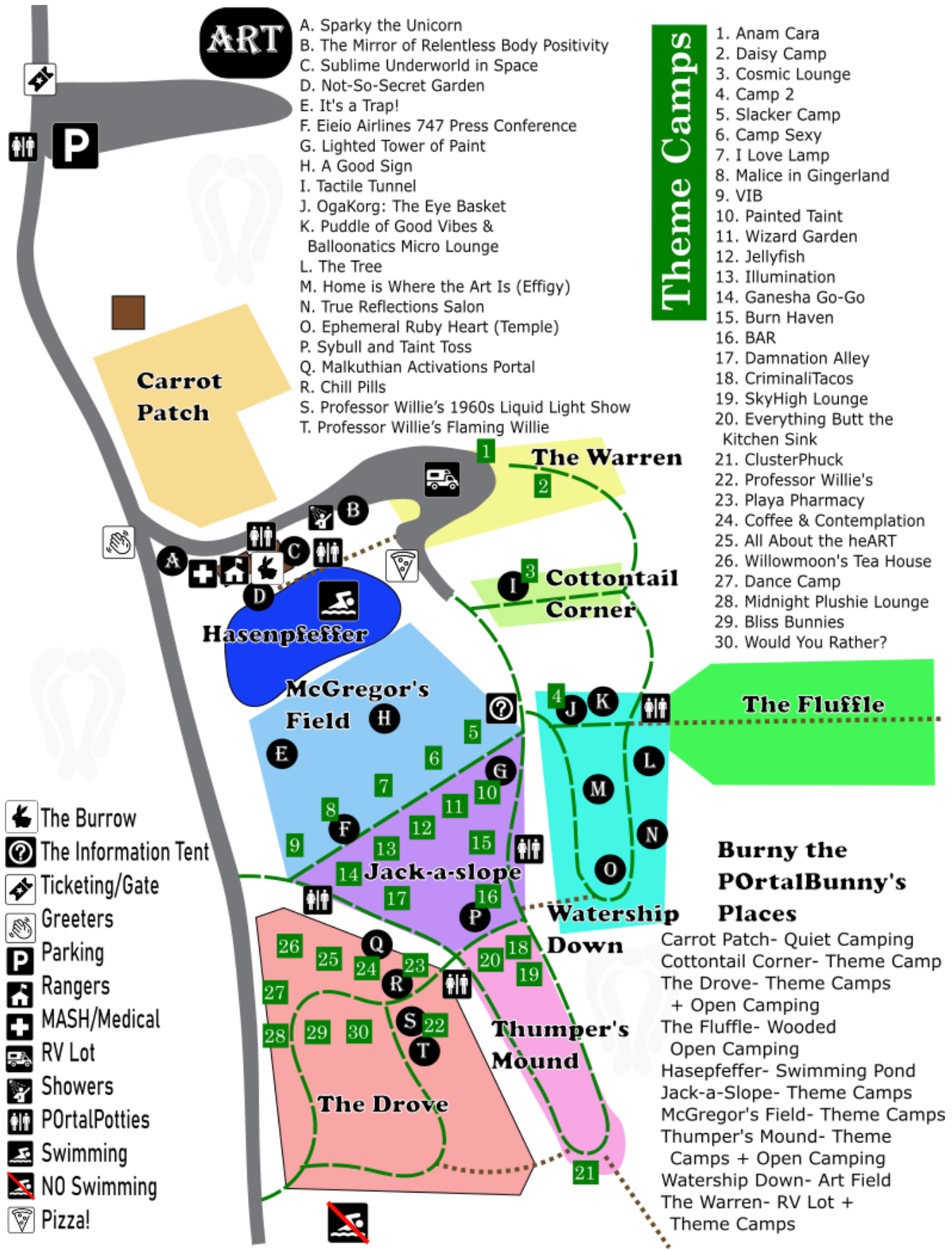

When confronted with art, do you sometimes have difficulty interpreting what it actually represents? This art doesn't need a degree in art or an artist's statement. Through the art itself (and assisted by appropriate signage), you should be able to figure this one out!

Lighted Tower of Paint

Art Burn

This installation is an obelisk lit with LED strips that dance to the music it plays! Its faces are painted in the style of acrylic pour paintings and its base holds 4 easels for the wonderful PortalBurn Community to express themselves through painting!

Malkuthian Activation Portals

Malkuth is a Hebrew word that can be understood as "Kingdom," and refers to the material world of the senses. The Malkuthian Activation Portals are made from bound sticks and ropes. Their design is drawn from each of the 5 universal elements of Air, Earth, Water, Fire and Ether, and they reflect and invoke these natural forces, both as art objects and/or focal points or meditation tools that focus energetic frequencies and activate different energy centers. Burners are invited to come and spend time with the portals.

Professor Willie's 1960s Liquid Light Show

ARTIST: Professor Willie

"Professor Willie's 1960s Liquid Light Show" is similar to the backdrops used by '60s psychedelic bands, such as Jefferson Airplane and Pink Floyd. Liquid light shows were an integral part of the '60s psychedelic music scene. Professor Willie's multimedia event includes projected slides, videos, laser patterns (even though lasers weren't available in the sixties), and most importantly, patterns produced using liquid dyes and colored oils. Tune in and turn on to the psychedelic imagery and music of the '60s!

Professor Willie's Flaming Willie

ARTIST: Professor Willie

"Professor Willie's Flaming Willie" is modelled after an antique physics apparatus: The Rubens Tube (circa 1905). Dance in front of flaming tubes pulsating in time with the music. Meditate on the scintillating scene. Fire and Music... what more could you want?

Sparky the Unicorn!

ARTIST: Nataraj

Sparky the Unicorn is a giant, mobile spectacular puppet/sculpture of a unicorn that can support two riders in the saddle at once. Sparky is covered by over 6000 LEDs and rainbow tulle fabric, and can be manipulated by participants to bring Sparky to life!

Sublime Underworld in Space

ARTIST: Mr Sunshine

Prepare to enter the Sublime Underworld, where the magic of our spirits is echoed by the very walls around us! The Sublime Underworld in Space serves as the vivid backdrop, a vibrant context for the creativity of all that choose to express themselves in the burrow. It is a fully immersive blacklight environment meant to accentuate the performances, dances and every other form of expression of all who dare to venture into its enticing depths. Not to mention it's a great place to just kick it and enjoy the ambiance.

Sybull and Taint Toss

Date & Location

Thursday July 28th 3pm - Monday, August 1st 12pm at Hummingbird Hill in Almond, NY.

Gate Hours

New arrivals will be permitted entry only during Gate hours. Gate hours for 2022 are as follows.

Thursday: 3 pm through Midnight

Friday: 8am through Midnight

Saturday: 8am through 8pm

Sunday: Gate is closed to new arrivals. Gate is open from Noon - 6pm for ticketed participants to depart and return in case of an emergency.

Monday: Gate is closed

Departure and re-entry is limited to emergencies only. There will be no traffic in or out of the event site during the Saturday and Sunday night burns; you can depart only after the burn is deemed 'safe' by our Fire Team.

Early Arrival

You can arrive earlier than 3 pm on Thursday only if you have prior authorization.

Tickets

Tickets must be purchased in advance. A Government Issued ID it must match the gate list. There is no will-call. Do not show up without a ticket.

Minors

Children 12 and under do not require a ticket.

Minors 13 – 20 require a ticket and will be provided an underage wristband.

Participants 21 and over require ID and a ticket, and will be provided an adult wristband.

People under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a 21+ parent or guardian at entry, and during the event. You are responsible for the welfare of minors in your care. You should know where your minors are at all times, and be aware that some activities are adult specific. Please write your name on the wristbands of the minors in your care. Failing to adequately supervise minors in your care is your fastest ticket out of POrtalBurn, as you may be immediately ejected without exception or recourse.

Anyone serving alcohol is responsible for identifying minors at their event. If you are serving alcohol you must check wristbands of anyone you are serving to be sure that they are of legal age. Do not serve minors. Period.

Pets

No, pets are not allowed.

Covid Protocol

We will follow NYS guidelines. If the guidelines change, we will update our policy accordingly.

We encourage all participants to exercise good common sense when it comes to public health as we believe it is our Civic Responsibility. With all we are learning regarding Covid variants, getting vaccinated is good common sense, and we hope everyone who is able to will get vaccinated prior to arrival. If you are unable or unwilling to get vaccinated, we suggest you wear a mask while in close proximity to others for your own safety, and for the good of the community. If you are unvaccinated, it would also be prudent to ensure you test negative for Covid prior to coming.

When we gather, we must all respect that every person has a different level of comfort, and their own unique circumstances. As always consent is key. Please ask permission to be in others personal bubbles, and be aware if someone is wearing a mask and honor their boundaries.

On-Site Parking

RVs, CAMPERS, SLEEPING VEHICLES

All RV, camper, and sleeping vehicle placement must be pre-approved (theme camp or not). If you do not have pre-approved on-site parking, you will need to park your vehicle in one of the main event parking lots. Do not bring an on-site vehicle (camper, van, RV, etc) without prior authorization, and do not anticipate sleeping in your vehicle in the parking lot.

Unloading and Parking

Primary parking is on-site, not far from open camping. You may be allowed to drive into parts of the event site to unload, then move your car to a parking area. If you arrive after dark, please use flashlights or headlamps while walking back to the event site. When you arrive, Parking volunteers will guide you.

Most of the open camping does not have vehicle access, so it will be 'walk in' with a load/unload zone not far away. We will have some wagons available to help make it easier, but you are encouraged to bring your own wagons and handcarts as well.

Most placed Theme Camps will have vehicle access for loading and unloading. Parking Volunteers will manage the number of vehicles permitted in the theme camp space at any given time. Once unloaded, theme camp vehicles will need to be moved out of the event space to the primary parking area, unless they have been granted permission by our Placement Lead to park onsite.

LOGISTICS

Open Camping

We are excited about returning to this site! We will have designated areas for theme camps, open camping, and some 'quieter' space. If you want really, really quiet, bring ear plugs. Most of the open camping will be on the hill, and there is a main field that will be used mostly for theme camps and big art. See the site map.

Volunteer

PORtalBurn is a volunteer driven event. On-site you can visit The Information Tent (TIT) to see the schedule and sign up for open shifts.

Water

We recommend bringing your own potable water for personal consumption and camp needs.

Ice

Ice will be available on-site from Thursday afternoon through most of the weekend. There will be a freezer near the pavilion stocked with bags. Recommended minimum donation is \$3 per bag.

Showers

There will be a communal shower shelter in a central area using potable water provided by our hosts. Reminder: This is a Leave No Trace event. Any soaps or shampoos MUST be environmentally friendly, biodegradable, and non-toxic. Please do not leave your shower supplies behind as a 'gif t'. That is just gross.

Pond Rules

Hummingbird Hill has a pond, and yes you may swim in it. Do not forget your floaties. Do not use waterways for dumping waste. This is a Leave No Trace event.

NO SWIMMING AFTER DARK, THOSE IN VIOLATION WILL BE REMOVED.

Trash

No. This is a 100% LNT (Leave No Trace) event. So, pack it in, pack it out. You are responsible for every piece of trash you generate. It is our Civic Responsibility to ensure our event does not negatively impact the community around us. DO NOT dump your trash at local businesses. It jeopardizes the future of our event.

Have a 'camp trash plan'. Discard product packaging prior to arrival. Bring trash bags. Embrace reusable supplies. Burn your burnable. Avoid glass containers. Collect your recycling. Bring your own portable ashtray. Keep trash and food in your camp covered and closed to avoid attracting wildlife. LNT means you pack it out with you.

Fire Safety

You can have a burn barrel or elevated fire pit. All fire pits, flame effects, fire circles, and propane/gas powered flames will be checked by our Fire Team. If there are any safety concerns, you must address them. Period.

Camps with fire must have a fire extinguisher (5 pounds, ABC type) or 5-gallon filled water bucket readily available. Do not leave any fire unattended.

All flaming art and pyrotechnics must be pre-approved.

DO NOT bring outside firewood. This region is extremely sensitive to the Emerald Ash Borer and wood from outside of the immediate area is prohibited. As part of your ticket price, PORtalBurn will provide locally obtained wood for the effigy burn, camp burn barrels, and fire pits. There will be a designated ash dump at the main burn pad. When you leave, you must dispose of any ashes from your burn barrel or fire pit responsibly. Do not discard any ashes or embers anyplace other than the designated ash dump.

Sound

Any camp with amplified sound must have placement.

Sound camps are expected to honor the following guidelines:

Position speakers and adjust levels so the sound is contained to your camp and doesn't bleed into other camps or open camping. Consult with your neighboring camps when positioning speakers to avoid conflict.

If you are asked by a neighboring camp to lower your sound, we expect you to resolve the issue amicably. If you are not able to resolve it, find the BOD on Call for assistance.

During the event, the sound will be monitored by volunteers. If you are asked to adjust your sound by someone in an official capacity, you are expected to comply.

Sound turndown is between 2am and 10am (74 decibels measured at 50' from the sound source). The BOD on Call has db meters available if you need help gauging an appropriate sound level. This is just a guideline. Even if you are within the db range, you may still be asked to turn it down if the situation warrants it. Sound carries in unpredictable ways, so on-site judgement calls may happen.

The PORtalBurn Sound Policy may be updated as the event unfolds, as deemed necessary. Sound Camps will be informed if changes arise, and will be expected to comply. Failure to comply with sound management requests may result in the camp losing sound privileges for the remainder of the event and possibly losing future sound privileges. Don't be that person. We want your sound!

LOGISTICS

Nudity

Nudity is allowed within the event space only. Nudity is not allowed at the Gate, entrance road, parking area, or any area that is visible to the general public outside of event attendees.

Laws

Yes. All New York State laws including those regarding drugs and alcohol apply. Upstate New York POrtalBurn Arts, Inc. (UNYPA) does not condone ANY illegal activity. While we are creating a temporary community with its own rules, this community coexists within an area of real laws.

Pictures, Film, Video

Participants understand they may be photographed at POrtalBurn, and that consent must be obtained for all photography, film, or video at the event. Any person identifiable in the image or video must express consent to be photographed or filmed, and photographers must destroy any image or video at the subject's request, even if prior consent had been granted.

Participants understand that it is prohibited to take photos or videos of a camp or person if a 'No Photos' sign is posted, or at an event where a 'No Photos' policy has been announced. Participants understand and accept that no use other than personal use of images, film, or video obtained at the event may be made without prior written permission from Upstate New York POrtalBurn Arts, Inc (UNYPA) and the written permission of any persons identifiable in the images, film or video.

Accessibility

The event site does not have paved roads. The main theme camp field and RV space is pretty flat and accessible, weather permitting. We welcome all participants; however, we cannot assure accessibility to all areas of the venue. We will have at least one wheelchair accessible porta potty, and will do our very best to accommodate needs.

Rangers

Rangers are helpful, clear-headed participants and non-confrontational volunteer mediators. They are not cops and not your mom, but good people to find if you need help! You can spot them in their super swanky khaki clothing. The TIT (The Information Tent) can radio a Ranger if one is needed.

First Aid

All POrtalBurners are expected to be self-reliant. This includes bringing any and all supplies you might need, such as OTC medication, first aid supplies, sunscreen, etc.

We will not have a staffed MASH camp. No medical services will be available. There will be a radio located in the self serve First-Aid station.

Rangers will be on duty and can help facilitate getting medical assistance if needed.

The nearest hospital is approximately 16 minutes away: Oswego Hospital, 110 W 6th St, Oswego, NY 13126

Waivers

You are responsible for your own health, safety, and well-being at all times before, during, and after the event. You will be asked to sign a waiver on arrival clarifying any liabilities.

TEN PRINCIPLES

Civic Responsibility

We value civil society. Community members who organize events should assume responsibility for public welfare and endeavor to communicate civic responsibilities to participants. They must also assume responsibility for conducting events in accordance with local, state and federal laws.

Radical Self-reliance

Burning Man encourages the individual to discover, exercise and rely on his or her inner resources.

Decommodification

Our community seeks to create social environments that are unmediated by commercial sponsorships, transactions, or advertising. We stand ready to protect our culture from such exploitation. We resist the substitution of consumption for participatory experience.

Radical Self-expression

Radical self-expression arises from the unique gifts of the individual. No one other than the individual or a collaborating group can determine its content. It is offered as a gift to others. In this spirit, the giver should respect the rights and liberties of the recipient.

Communal Effort

We value creative cooperation and collaboration. We strive to produce, promote and protect social networks, public spaces, works of art, and methods of communication that support such interaction.

Leave No Trace

We respect the environment and are committed to leaving no physical trace of our activities wherever we gather. We clean up after ourselves and endeavor to leave such places in a better state than when we found them.

Gifting

Burning Man is devoted to acts of gift giving. The value of a gift is unconditional. Gifting is not bartering.

Radical Inclusion

Anyone may be a part of Burning Man. We welcome and respect the stranger. No prerequisites exist for participation in our community.

Participation

Transformative change, whether in the individual or in society, can occur only through deeply personal participation. We achieve being through doing. Everyone is invited to work. Everyone is invited to play. We make the world real through actions that open the heart.

Immediacy

Immediate experience is, in many ways, the most important touchstone of value in our culture. We seek to overcome barriers that stand between us and a recognition of our inner selves, the reality of those around us, participation in society, and contact with a natural world exceeding human powers.
