Please stay aware of any changes to state and local guidelines. PORtalBurn will follow those guidelines and adjust

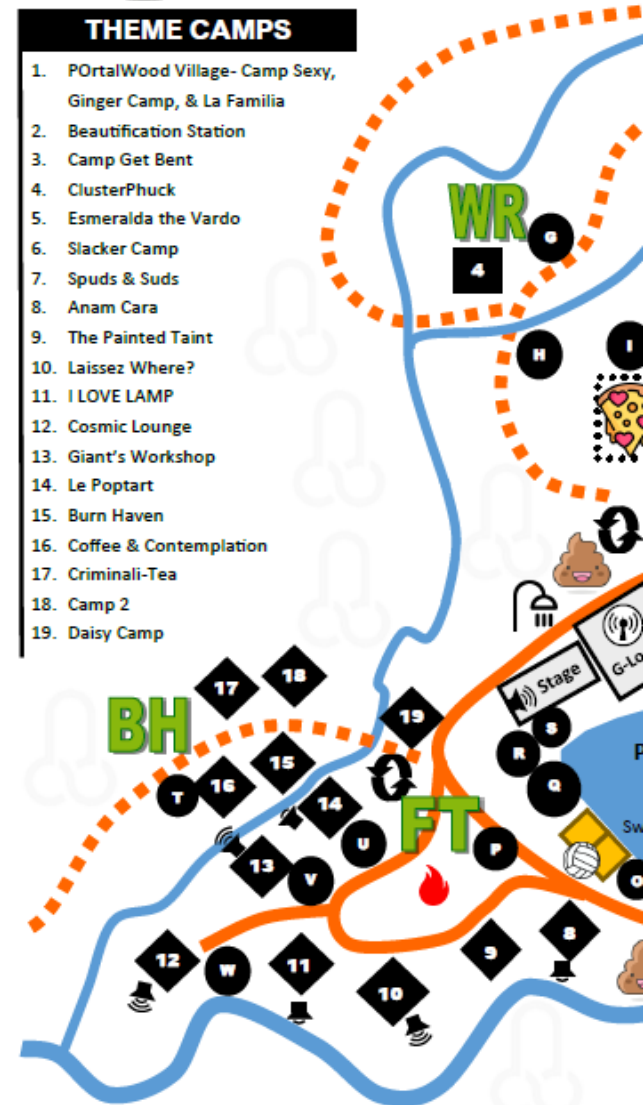

**EFFIGY*****Bower*****ARTIST: Quentin Davis**

It is named for the constructions of the male Bowerbird who build these bowers, or dance platforms, from sticks and found junk, berries, and shells. The purpose is to attract a mate who will come, inspect the artistry, sample the berries and if impressed will allow the male bird to mate with her. I've made it human scale. The Bowerbird has a strange quirk in which it likes things of a particular hue. It will find every piece of plastic junk (for example) and decorate his bower with this junk.

**TEMPLE*****Our Final Hour*****ARTIST: Yash 2.0**

This Temple is my interpretation on the importance and meaning of immediacy. Representing the final moments you know you have with someone, or something before they leave your life forever. And, serves as a tribute to those who are already gone but live within our hearts.

***Corona Man*****ARTIST: Saint**

Effigy figure, but made out of Corona beer cases with wooden supports inside. Similar to the classic 'Burning Man'. Should be very popular to see it burn after all we've been through. This is intended to be burned after the main effigy. This can stand somewhere close to the burn field, with the intent that 4+ people can carry it to the burn pad after the main effigy burns, or after other burnable art is burned. Let's burn Corona Man!!

***Deb The Disco Bus*****ARTIST: Nick Rothlein**

Disco is NOT Dead! Disco is life! Callin' all you Foxy Mama's & Casanova's; Don't be a bunny, come boogie down with Deb the Disco Bus, lit up out of site (you actually can't miss her)... Disco Ball & all!!

She'll be parked at Giants Workshop all weekend long, bumping the classics, and everything in between. DJ's on the roof top stage, libations and good vibes on the dance floor. Can ya dig? Awwwww sooky sooky!

***Hammock Haven*****ARTIST: Michael Davey**

Come chill the fuck out! Hop into a hammock and take a load off! Ask any leisure professional (me), a hammock is the place to be! We will be open all day and half the night! Please make your own tickets and bring them to enter the Haven. (not required for entry)

# LOGISTICS

## *Location*

PORtalBurn 2021 is the official Upstate NY Regional Burn held on private property at 81 Keller Road, Hannibal NY 13074. The event starts at Noon, Fri Sept 3, and ends at Noon, Mon Sept 6.

## *Gate Hours*

New arrivals will be permitted entry only during Ticketing hours. Planned hours for 2021 are:

- Friday Ticketing: Noon through Midnight
- Saturday Ticketing: 8am through 8pm
- Sunday Re-Entry Only: Noon through 8pm

Re-entry is available only during Gate hours, and up until 8pm Sunday night. There will be no re-entry after 8pm Sunday night. There will be no traffic movement in or out of the event site during art burns (approx 9:00 pm to midnight Sat & Sun); you can depart only after the burn is deemed 'safe' by our Fire Team.

## *Early Arrival*

If you are not pre-approved for early arrival, do not show up before Noon on Friday.

## *Tickets*

Tickets will not be sold at the gate. There is no will call for tickets. The gate will not hold 'gift' tickets. Do not arrive without a ticket. Print your ticket in advance, or download it to your phone. Cell service is spotty, be sure you have access to your ticket prior to arrival.

If you have a ticket you cannot use, you can sell it at face value, and transfer the ticket to the recipient in Burner Tickets before they arrive at the event. They will need the ticket number.

## *Wristbands*

Everyone attending PORtalBurn will be given a wristband that must be worn at all times. If lost or damaged, go to Ticketing for a replacement. Anyone found without a wristband may be ejected from the event. Please write on your wristband (1) Your real name, (2) Where you are camping and, if applicable, (3) The name of the parent or guardian that is with you at the event. This information will help our MASH or Ranger volunteers if assistance is needed.

## *Unloading and Parking*

All open camping is 'walk in' as well as some placed theme camps. Pull into the event site to unload in a designated 'loading zone', then move your car to parking and walk back to the event site to move on to your campsite. There will be large wagons available to help make it easier. You are encouraged to bring your own wagons and handcarts as well.

Theme Camps in Falcontown and Popinjay Perch do have vehicle access for loading and unloading. Parking will manage the number of vehicles permitted in the theme camp space at any given time. Once unloaded, theme camp vehicles will need to be moved to the primary parking area unless they have received prior approval for on-site parking.

## *Open Camping*

There is open camping available throughout the event site, mostly in the woods. Be prepared to clear some space for your campsite. We will provide rakes you can borrow. Look up when pitching your tent and be cautious of tenting under trees with precarious limbs. No open camping is considered 'quiet' however Quails Quorner is likely your best bet, as it is the farthest from any sound camps. If you truly need quiet, bring earplugs. See the site map for details.

## ***On-Site Parking***

### ***RVs, CAMPERS, SLEEPING VEHICLES***

RV, camper and sleeping vehicle placement must be pre-approved. You will receive a pass for your vehicle at the gate. Please display it on your dashboard, and consult with Parking Volunteers for placement instructions. Do not bring an on-site vehicle (camper, sleeper van, RV, etc) without prior authorization.

## ***Trash***

This is a 100% pack it in, pack it out event. You are responsible for every piece of trash you generate. We do not provide trash receptacles of any kind. Bring trash bags and make use of reusable supplies. Burn your burnables. Avoid glass containers. If you smoke, bring your own portable ashtray. Keep trash and food in your camp covered and closed to avoid attracting wildlife. Leave No Trace means you bring it out with you. Do not leave it bagged up expecting the POrtalBurn volunteers to take care of it after you leave. Do not dump your trash at local businesses.

## ***Exodus***

POrtalBurn ends at Noon on Monday. Please have an exodus plan that will get you packed up and out in a timely manner. Our Exodus and DPW Volunteers cannot finish their jobs until the last participant has left. Our goal is to have everyone gone by 3pm. Thank you!

## ***Pavilion***

The pavilion is central to the event space and will be equipped with a sound system you can use to DJ and host your events. The schedule and sign ups will be posted in the pavilion. There is electricity in pavilion, however it is not intended for general camp use. We anticipate the electricity will be used for activities in the pavilion, and our Safety Core volunteers.

## **LOGISTICS cont'd**

### ***Water***

Potable will be available on site from large cisterns. It will not be enough to supply all participants through the event, so please bring your own water.

### ***Showers***

There will be a communal shower shelter on-site. Any soap or shampoo **MUST** be environmentally friendly. Please do not leave your shower supplies behind. If you choose to set up your own shower system, there is space in the woods. Be cognizant of any water runoff and how it may affect other participants, and ensure it's at least 100 feet away from the creek.

### ***Pond and Stream Rules***

There is no swimming at any time in the pond. While you can use the stream, we do not recommend it. There are beavers in the area that can transmit Giardiasis, an intestinal parasite. Do not use stream water on anything ingestible, and wash hands thoroughly if you go into the stream. Do not use the stream for dumping waste items.

### ***Ice and Supplies***

Ice will be available on site from through most of the event. There will be a freezer stocked with 7lb bags. Recommended minimum donation is \$3 per bag. Please avoid driving to town, and restock your ice on site. Any extra proceeds will benefit POrtalBurn Art Grants for 2020! Other than ice, no amenities or supplies will be sold at POrtalBurn. On-site vending is prohibited. There are a variety of stores within 15 minutes of the event site. Google is your friend, plan accordingly.

## ***Fire Safety***

### **BURN BARRELS and CAMP FIRES:**

Burn barrel or elevated fire pits are permitted. Campfires must be at your campsite, raised off the ground, in an elevated contained barrel or fire pit. Camps with fire **MUST** have a fire extinguisher (5 lb, ABC type) or 5-gallon filled water-bucket readily available. If you bring fire, you must Leave No Trace.

### **FIREWOOD:**

Do not bring outside firewood. POrtalBurn provides locally obtained wood for burn barrels and fire pits. When you leave, you must dispose of any ashes from your burn barrel or fire pit responsibly at the designated ash dump, at the main burn pad.

### **FIREWORKS:**

Only fountain type fireworks may be used, and only in burnable art, and only with prior authorization. Our Fire Team needs to know about any pyrotechnics you have planned. All burnable art will be inspected by the Fire Lead before it is set ablaze. Any pyrotechnic devices not previously approved by the Fire lead will be confiscated, and disposed of. You may be subject to expulsion from the event at the BODs discretion.

### **FIRE EFFECTS:**

If you're bringing flame effects, you need to be placed. That way we know you are there. This includes, but is not limited to flame projectors, poofers, propane fueled art, etc. Have a fire extinguisher nearby.

### **FIRE SPINNING:**

If theme camps wish to host a fire circle they must mark an area that has been cleared of debris and flammable objects, and must be approved by the Fire lead before spinning may occur. Fuel should be stored in an appropriate fuel dump safely outside the fire area. Every fire performer is expected to have a designated safety person, fire blanket and fire extinguisher.

## **Generators**

Please do whatever you can to mitigate sound, and be considerate of your neighbors. Do not run generator/power cords across walking/driving paths, and be conscious of positioning your generator safely if it's in a wooded area. Generators do not need to be inspected, but if the Fire Team does spot unsafe setup or use, the camp will be expected to change it.

## **Sound**

Only placed Theme Camps can have amplified sound. Sound camps are expected to honor the following guidelines. Position speakers and adjust levels so sound is contained to your camp and doesn't bleed into other camps or open camping. Bass travels farther than the event. If there is a neighbor complaint, we will ask you to turn down your bass at night, or possibly turn off your subs. If you are asked by a neighboring camp to lower your sound, we expect you to resolve the issue together. If you are not able to resolve it, please find the BOD on Call to assist. During the event, sound will be monitored. If you are asked to adjust your sound by someone in an official capacity, you are expected to comply. Sound turndown is between 2am and 10am to 74 decibels (measured at 50' from the sound source). Sound volunteers have db meters available if you need help gauging an appropriate sound level. Even if you are within the decibel range, you may still be asked to turn it down if the situation warrants it. The POrtalBurn Sound Policy is subject to change as the event unfolds, as deemed necessary. Sound Camps will be informed if changes arise. Failure to comply will result in the camp losing sound privileges for the remainder of the event and possibly lose future sound privileges.

## **LOGISTICS cont'd**

### **Minors**

Children 12 and under do not require a ticket. Minors 13 – 20 will require a ticket and will be provided an underage wristband. Participants 21 and over require ID and a ticket, and will be provided an adult wristband. People under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a 21+ parent or guardian, both at entry, and during the event. You are responsible for the welfare of minors in your care. You should know where your minors are at all times, and be aware that some activities are adult specific. Please write your name on the wristbands of the minors in your care. Failing to adequately supervise minors in your care is your fastest ticket out of POrtalBurn, as you may be immediately ejected without exception or recourse. Anyone serving alcohol is responsible for identifying minors at their event. If you are serving alcohol you must check wristbands of anyone you are serving to be sure that they are of legal age. Do not serve minors. Period.

### **Pets**

No pets are allowed. The policy regarding service animals can be found here <https://portalburn.org/documents/>

### **Nudity**

Nudity is allowed within the event space only. Nudity is not allowed at the Gate, entrance road, parking area, or any area that is visible to the general public outside of event attendees.

### **POrtal Potties**

If it didn't come out of your body, don't put it in the potty. Single ply TP only. Please use them responsibly.

## ***Rangers***

Rangers are helpful, clear-headed participants and non-confrontational volunteer mediators. They are not your cops and not your mom, but good people to find if you need help! You can spot them in their super swanky khaki clothing. The TIT (The Information Tent) can radio a Ranger if one is needed.

## ***Volunteer***

POrtalBurn is a volunteer driven event. On-site you can visit The Information Tent (TIT) to see the schedule and sign up for open shifts.

## ***Accessibility***

The event site does not have paved roads. The main theme camp field is pretty flat and accessible. And there are some established paths through the woods, but most are fairly rugged, with inclines. Open camping will be in the wooded areas, and will all be mostly walk in camping. We welcome all participants, however we cannot assure accessibility to all areas of the venue. We will have at least one wheelchair accessible porta potty, and will do our very best to accommodate needs.

## ***First Aid***

All POrtalBurners are expected to be self reliant. This includes bringing any supplies you might need, such as OTC medication, first aid supplies, sunscreen, etc. We will have a First Aid station and some volunteers on site to help with minor emergencies. If unmanned, please use the radio to ask for help or find a ranger. No medical services will be available, but volunteers can assist participants with obtaining appropriate care. Rangers will also be on duty and can help facilitate getting medical assistance if needed. The nearest hospital facility is approximately 16 minutes away: Oswego Hospital, 110 W 6<sup>th</sup> St, Oswego, NY 13126

## ***Waivers***

POrtalBurn, leads/coordinators, and the landowner are NOT responsible for your safety or belongings before, during, or after the event. You will sign a waiver on arrival acknowledging any liabilities.

## ***Pictures, Film, Video***

Participants understand they may be photographed, consent must be obtained by any person identifiable in any image or video. Camps, persons, or events may have “NO PHOTOS” signs and this must be respected. Special thanks to all of the department leads and volunteers who make POrtalBurn possible.

## ***Laws***

All New York State and federal laws including those regarding drugs and alcohol apply. Upstate New York POrtalBurn Arts, Inc. (UNYPA) does not condone any illegal activity. While we are creating a temporary community with its own rules, this community coexists within an area of real laws.

## TEN PRINCIPLES

### *Civic Responsibility*

We value civil society. Community members who organize events should assume responsibility for public welfare and endeavor to communicate civic responsibilities to participants. They must also assume responsibility for conducting events in accordance with local, state and federal laws.

### *Radical Self-reliance*

Burning Man encourages the individual to discover, exercise and rely on his or her inner resources.

### *Decommodification*

Our community seeks to create social environments that are unmediated by commercial sponsorships, transactions, or advertising. We stand ready to protect our culture from such exploitation. We resist the substitution of consumption for participatory experience.

### *Radical Self-expression*

Radical self-expression arises from the unique gifts of the individual. No one other than the individual or a collaborating group can determine its content. It is offered as a gift to others. In this spirit, the giver should respect the rights and liberties of the recipient.

### *Communal Effort*

We value creative cooperation and collaboration. We strive to produce, promote and protect social networks, public spaces, works of art, and methods of communication that support such interaction.

### *Leave No Trace*

We respect the environment and are committed to leaving no physical trace of our activities wherever we gather. We clean up after ourselves and endeavor to leave such places in a better state than when we found them.

### *Gifting*

Burning Man is devoted to acts of gift giving. The value of a gift is unconditional. Gifting is not bartering.

### *Radical Inclusion*

Anyone may be a part of Burning Man. We welcome and respect the stranger. No prerequisites exist for participation in our community.

### *Participation*

Transformative change, whether in the individual or in society, can occur only through deeply personal participation. We achieve being through doing. Everyone is invited to work. Everyone is invited to play. We make the world real through actions that open the heart.

### *Immediacy*

Immediate experience is, in many ways, the most important touchstone of value in our culture. We seek to overcome barriers that stand between us and a recognition of our inner selves, the reality of those around us, participation in society, and contact with a natural world exceeding human powers.
